The history of the study of Lake Baikal dates back to more than a century. The beginning of the history of the study is considered to be 1643 when the first map of Lake Baikal was drawn. Constant research of Lake Baikal, its fauna and the formation of scientific collections started in 1916 when the Committee for the study of Lake Baikal headed by academician Nikolai Nasonov was organized at the Presidium of the Russian Academy of Sciences (RAS). Since 1924 there was a permanent expedition, then Baikal Biological (Limnological) Station (1928) and Limnological Institute SB RAS (1961). Museum expositions have existed throughout all these years up to 1993 – the year of establishment independent Baikal Museum. Thus, in 2023 Baikal Museum celebrates its 30th anniversary!

To commemorate this event Baikal Museum holds the traditional Conference "Development of Life on Earth in abiotic change processes"



The purpose of the conference is to create a scientific discussion platform for discussing modern scientific knowledge on the origin of life and its development in the course of changes taking place on Earth. Particular attention will be paid to the origin of Lake Baikal biota in the process of global and local changes.

The integration of knowledge about the Earth, evolution processes (including Lake Baikal, as a natural area where the structures of the environment, flora and fauna are jointly formed) will have not only fundamental, but also practical significance: a strategy for modern scientific knowledge, which is the primary focus of the Museum's work, will be worked out as a result of the conference.

Within the framework of the conference, a school section is provided, which is aimed at raising the educational level of the younger generation and scientific and pedagogical personnel, attracting young people to participate in promising scientific research.

- Coevolution of abiotic and biotic processes and events (modern view an theories)
- Evolution on Earth (Precambrian, Paleozoic, Mesozoic, Cenozoic)

- Organic world of Pleistocene and Holocene, evolution of ecosystems, ancient human
- Life in aquatic ecosystems
- Climate change and dynamics of ecosystems and their elements: the last glaciation in Eurasia



Title of the manuscript – (Times New Roman 14 pt, bold) Surname and name of each author (Times New Roman 14 pt, italics) Authors' affiliations (full postal address of each affiliation) *Corresponding author
